



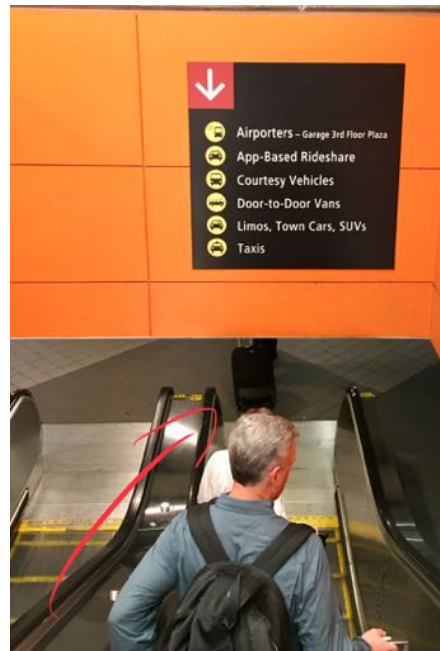
HOW TO GET FROM SEATAC AIRPORT TO SEATTLE PACIFIC UNIVERSITY

THE FASTEST AND MOST DIRECT METHOD:

TAXI from SeaTac Airport to SPU/Emerson Hall:

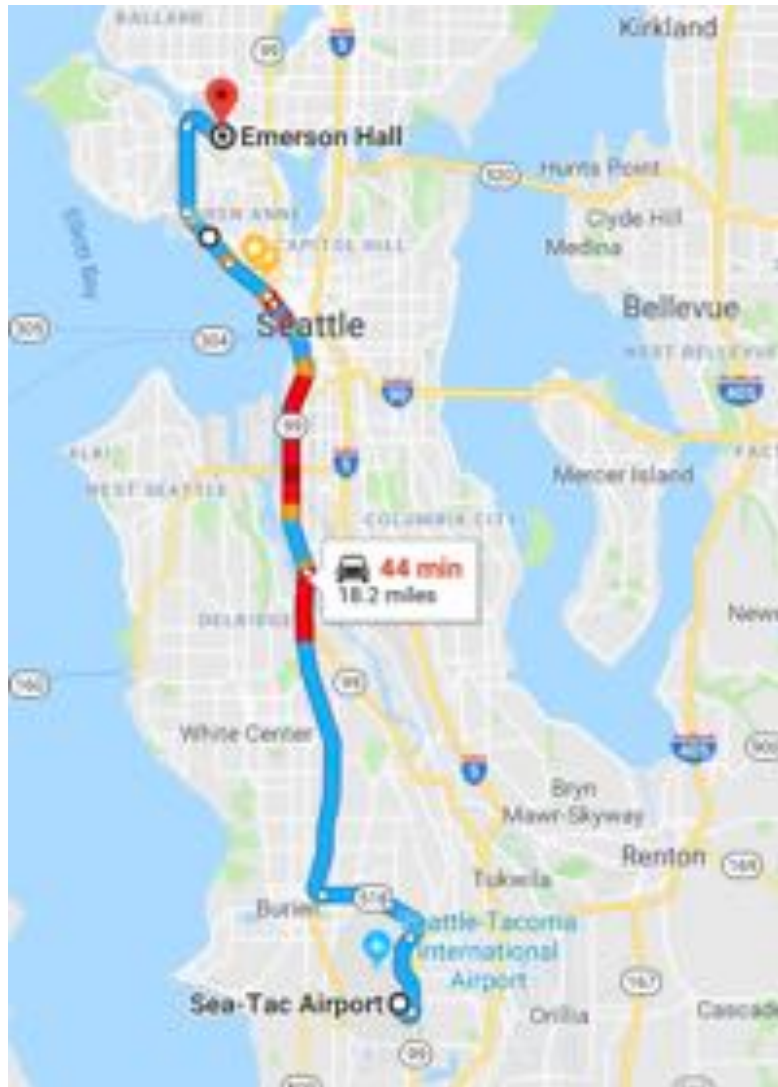
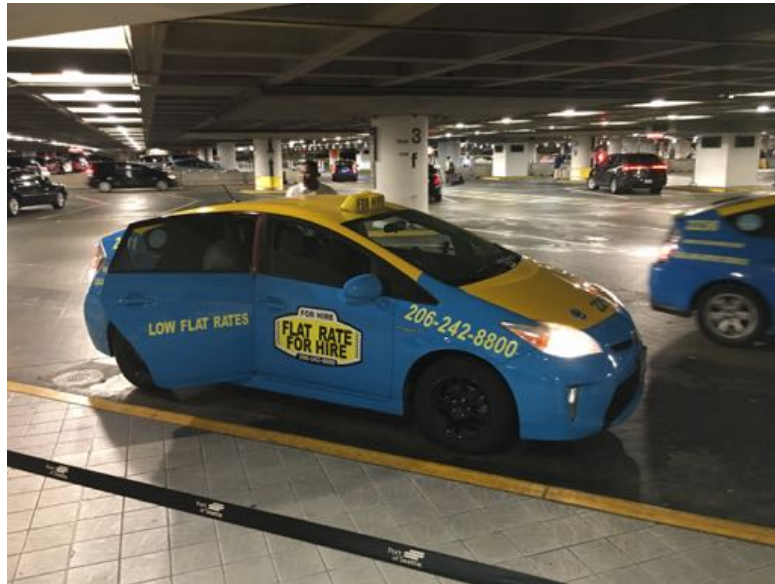
3 Take the bridge across to FLOOR 4 and then DOWN to FLOOR 3

Go to the TAXI stand and ask the dispatcher for a “Taxi to Emerson Hall at Seattle Pacific University. The address is: [500 W Emerson St, Seattle, WA 98119](https://www.google.com/maps/place/500+W+Emerson+St,+Seattle,+WA+98119)”

Choose ONLY the Blue and Yellow cab (this is the cheapest at about **\$42 + tip**). This could accommodate 2 people with luggage or 3 without it. If you prefer a bigger car, ask for a van that accommodates from 5 to 6 people, the cost is **\$50 + tip**.



ALTERNATIVE METHOD

TRAIN from SeaTac Airport to UNIVERSITY STATION, then BUS #13 to SEATTLE PACIFIC UNIVERSITY

<p>1</p> <p>Arrival at SEATAC Airport</p> <p>Pick up your luggage and on the same floor go towards Baggage Claim #16</p>	
<p>2</p> <p>Take escalator UP to SKY BRIDGE #5 or #6</p>	

3 Take the bridge across to FLOOR 4 and then LEFT to the LINK LIGHT RAIL Station



How to use light rail and how to pay: You can buy train tickets using cash or a credit card from station vending machines. Price is \$3.25.

Hours: The first train leaves UW Station at 4:45 a.m. The final night train returns at 12:50 a.m.

Duration: The trip from Sea-Tac Airport to University of WA station takes 46 minutes, with stops at 14 stations.

Frequency: Every 6 minutes during peak hours; every 10 minutes midday; every 15 minutes after 10 p.m.

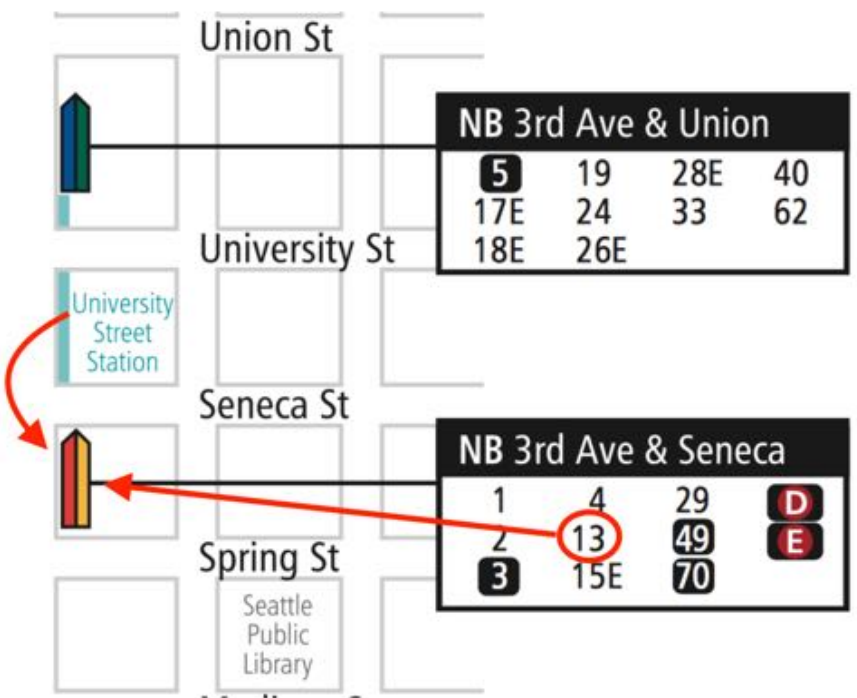

GET OFF the Link Light Rail at the UNIVERSITY STREET STATION (11 stops from the airport)

GO UP to the Street Level and GO SOUTH for ONE BLOCK – to the BUS STOP at 3rd and SENECA.

Board BUS #13 to SEA PAC UNIV (fare is \$2.75, you pay with cash directly at the bus. NOTE: there is no change



provided, so you need to have this amount)



5 GET OFF the bus at W. CREMONA ST.



WALK to EMERSON HALL (5-6 minutes). There will be conference volunteers to meet and greet you in the lobby and provide you with your room key and other information.
